NOTIFICATION

1. Short title and commencement :-

- (1) These rules may be called as the "Survey of India Surveyor Recruitment Rules, 2018".
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their Publication in the Official Gazette.

2. <u>Initial Constitution</u>:

- i) The incumbents to the post of Surveyor (Ordinary Grade) holding the same on regular basis on the date of commencement of the rules, shall be deemed to have been appointed to the said post as mentioned in the first column of the Schedule under these rules.
- **ii**) The incumbent Topo Trainee Type A will be classified as Surveyor on the completion of their training period. However, they would be senior to the Surveyors appointed under these Rules through method of direct recruitment.
- **iii)** The incumbents holding the post of Survey Assistants on the date of commencement of the rules, shall be re-designated as Surveyor. Their seniority in the post of Surveyor will be same as that in the combined seniority list of Surveyors and Survey Assistants.

3. Number of Posts, Classification and level in the pay matrix :-

The number of the said posts, their classification, grades and the level in the pay matrix attached to these posts shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule, annexed to these rules.

Method of recruitment, age limit and other qualifications etc: The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in Columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualification:- No person,:-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living,

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts.

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- **Power to relax**: Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- **Saving**: Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Exserviceman and other special categories of persons, in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
